The Westport Weston Health District is seeking to hire a Registered Nurse to provide community health services in an expanded public health nursing role. Job duties include coordination of contact tracing efforts of communicable diseases, assisting in the analyses of surveillance data, development of community health education programs and presentations, and administering immunizations, testing, and screening services in the Health District's travel and other clinics; and does related public health work.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

A Baccalaureate degree in Nursing granted by a college or university with a National League for Nursing approved Community Health Nursing Program and possession and maintenance of a State of Connecticut Registered Professional Nursing or APRN License is required. Valid license to operate a motor vehicle in Connecticut.
