I understand that the Connecticut Public Health Code requires the abandonment of septic tanks and hollow leaching system structures to prevent inadvertent collapse hazards when they are no longer in use. As the owner and at my discretion, I am requesting that I be allowed to keep the hollow leaching system structures intact for some future use such as storm water retention.

As the owner, I accept full responsibility and any liability for these structures to remain under the ground in their present state. Furthermore, it is understood it is my responsibility to check with my home insurance carrier to determine if my homeowners insurance policy would cover any negligence claim resulting from any inadvertent collapse of the remaining hollow leaching system structure in the future.
