Effective immediately, the Aspetuck Health District will no longer submit unengorged ticks to the Connecticut Agriculture Experiment Station (CAES) for testing due to a change in CAES policy.

However, the Aspetuck Health District will continue to identify ticks for residents and the processing and handling fee is \$10.00.

You will receive a call from a staff member notifying you as to whether the tick is engorged and sent or, unengorged and not sent.

Only ticks attached to humans will be identified and tested.
